

MAEAP FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN EDUCATIONAL CREDIT FORM



Farmers and landowners who wish to become MAEAP verified can meet the educational requirement by 1) attending an approved meeting, 2) watching approved videos/webinars on the MAEAP web site, or by 3) completing a minimum of 2 hours of one-on-one forestry education through the development of a forest management plan with a qualified professional. The qualified professional must fit one of these criteria:

1. The Society of American Foresters Certified Forester
2. Registered Forester with Michigan Department of Natural Resources
3. Technical Service Provider for CAP 106 Forest Management Plan
4. Technical Service Provider for CAP 142 Fish & Wildlife Habitat Plan
5. Forest Stewardship Program plan writer
6. Association of Consulting Foresters member
7. Other individual recognized by MDARD to write forest management plans
