Cooking Up Conservation

Guidelines for Contestants to Follow

These Guidelines are required if you are submitting a pie to be judged during the Annual Tree Sale. If you submit a pie that does not follow these guidelines, you will be disqualified. Thank you for following the guidelines!

Pies

- Please commit to baking two (2) of the same pie for submission.
 - One for the judges to taste, one to be shared with visitors
- Pies must be made with an item that's for sale during Tree Sale
 - ex: apple and rhubarb qualify, pecan and pumpkin do not
- Ingredient list needs to be submitted with pie submission; **no cream based pies** please
- Preferred to know the specific fruit to be able to share what they would taste like
 - ex: Bailey Hardy Peach, Toka Plum, Fireside Apple

Entry Requirements

- Must be home baked with an item available at Tree Sale
- Must be an Alger County resident or landowner
- Must include whole recipe during submission
- Provide consent to photographs of yourself and your pie being shared

Voting process

- Judges will be tasting the pies and announcing the winner during Tree Sale
- Please be present for the announcement; we will update you when the time is scheduled

Awards

- Each contestant will be provided with a \$25 coupon to go towards this years (2026) Tree Sale rootstock
- The winner overall will earn a trophy, bragging rights, and be dubbed The Phenomenal Pie Master of Alger County
