Becoming a Member of the All Saints Legacy Society

Membership is easy. All you need to do is notify the Parish Office of your intent to name All Saints Episcopal Church of the North Shore in your estate plan.

The size or type of your bequest doesn't matter. Anyone may become a Legacy Society member regardless of the size or type of legacy gift committed. Spouses of donors are automatically included as Legacy Society members too.

Leaving something behind for the church you love will have a huge impact on the future of All Saints North Shore. A set dollar amount or percentage, or even the remainder of an estate — after you have provided for family—can add up to a large All Saints endowment if many people in the community join our Legacy Society.

The amount is up to you to decide, with the advice of your lawyer or financial advisor.
And, your declaration of a planned gift is non-binding. You may change your mind at any time during your life.

All information about your planned gift is kept strictly confidential. But choosing to be listed as a member of the Legacy Society enables you to give witness to the value of All Saints North Shore in your life, and to help secure its ministries and mission for generations to come.

Forms of Planned Giving

A Bequest in a Will: The easiest and most common way of making a planned gift. You can designate a specific amount of money, a percentage of your estate, or a specific asset. All Saints could also be named as a contingent beneficiary.

Life Income Gifts such as a charitable gift annuity, a charitable remainder trust, or a pooled income fund provide you and/or your designated beneficiary income for life. Upon your passing, the church receives the gift. Life income gifts generally reduce or eliminate certain taxes and guarantee an income for life.

Life Insurance can be used to make a sizeable gift to All Saints. For example, you can purchase a new policy and make the church the owner and beneficiary of the policy or make All Saints the owner and beneficiary of an existing policy you no longer need. You can also name All Saints a contingent beneficiary of an existing policy
