Check Prior To Use



Introduction: A container check prior to use is a **mandatory process** which must be carried out in compliance with **FAA, EASA and UK CAA rules and regulation.**

THE ULD CONTAINERS MUST BE CHECKED FOR SERVICABILITY, SAFE OPERATION AND AIRWORTHY CONDITION BEFORE AND AFTER USE AND ON THE COMPLETION OF REPAIR WORK

- ❖ It is the responsibility of the Handling Agent to perform the Container Check.
- ❖ The check must be carried out prior to Pre-conditioning, Loading and Storage of a Container.
- ❖ You must carry out an extensive and thorough visual check of all parts, joints and attachments using adequate lighting and where necessary inspection aids such as mirrors and hand lenses.
- ❖ Damaged containers shall not be used and must be returned immediately to UniLode
- ❖ Written records of every check must be taken, kept and made available upon request.
- ❖ Non-compliance may be subject to fines issued by the Aviation Authorities.
