Looking back over my time in leadership with the Billings Arts Association I am honored to have served you as Executive Director and feel that I am leaving an organization that has not only weathered the brunt of the pandemic but has engaged members in new activities and forged some new community

relationships. Through the Billings Cultural Partners, we have expanded locations for our onsite and plein air painting. Look over the schedule and join us. We are collaborating with grant writers and finding new partners for place-based community art making. These include DanWalt Gardens, St. Andrews Church (Pollinators Fair), Pompey's Pillar and more. Stay tuned for announcements of future exciting projects. Many of these events allow the public to talk with our artists while they create and to try out the materials themselves. These activities support our BAA mission statement of "... encourage(ing) participation in, and appreciation of the visual arts and supports arts education with material grants at every level."

We welcome a revitalized relationship with the Yellowstone Art Museum and their new leadership staff (our group was instrumental in early fundraising efforts and establishing a center from what was a county jail set for demolition). We are grateful for the continued partnership with Crooked Line Studio and their great staff. Many of our members have found a community atmosphere during the Open Studio times (Monday evening or Friday morning) and others have found a place to share their creative flow through teaching classes.

I believe that our members are the greatest strength of the Billings Arts Association. Embrace the opportunities provided and suggest new ones that **you** want to help make happen! Thanks for your trust in me these past three years and plan to engage in the passions and ideas of your new BAA leadership team.



BAA Board Minutes

April 21, 2022

The meeting was held at the home of Elizabeth Waddington. As executive director, she called the meeting to order just after 3:00. Also attending were John Kennedy, Ev Bergeron-- Assistant Director, Sandy Raymond—Treasurer, and Susan Lyons—Secretary. John is slated to be the Executive Director for 2022-2023.

The minutes were approved as read. Sandy gave the treasurer's report and it was approved. She will file a report with the Secretary of State.

The group discussed whether or not the revised bylaws should be filed with the state, and it was agreed that they should be. The BAA also needs to pay the 20.00 fee to the secretary of state to renew the business license.

Sandy reported that to date, 77 members have paid their dues. She has two P.O. box keys and will give one to the incoming secretary, Patti Gordon.

Elizabeth suggested that we print a postcard of BAA's upcoming events, since we have a full schedule this year. It was agreed that we do so and put artwork of the officers on one side.

The picnic will be held June 18 at Veteran's park, time TBD. Chalet Market will do the catering. The board decided to pay for the meals (3 choices) and attendees will bring their own beverages. Board members will provide a gift or two each for prize drawings. Sign up information will be in the May newsletter.

Submissions to the May Newsletter must be to Ev by May 1.

Elizabeth met with Jessica Ruhle, new Executive Director at Yellowstone Art Museum, to discuss whether or not the BAA would like to hold monthly ArtShops at the YAM. There are some stipulations, such as a start time of 10:15, and also a few months when the space there would not be available to us. We decided to agree tentatively to have a few meetings there to see how it goes. Elizabeth said that it would be good to strengthen our ties to YAM so she will work on a tentative agreement with staff there. There will be no financial outlay to hold ArtShops at that venue.

The board discussed various learning opportunities at ArtShop including ideas such as photographing your artwork for online submissions, isolation coating, and watercolor paper wrap.

After discussion, the board decided to continue the gentle used Art Materials Swap on an annual basis and allow for craft and mixed media materials.

Grant with Healthy by Design & the City of Billings. More information about the project will be available in June.

Fourteen artists have signed up for the event at DanWalt Gardens on May 8, and 4 for the pollinator event at the St. Andrews Gardens on June 25.

Elizabeth will send out forms for artist opportunities such as the Sweet Pea Festival, Summer Fair, and the MAPS program.

A Golden representative, Nancy Seiler, will put on a demonstration at Crooked Line Studio on June 28, 5:30-7:30. There is no charge but the limit is 35 people. Registration will be through Crooked Line Studio.

The next meeting will be July 21, location TBD.
