Saul Of Tarsus: How A Pharisee Become A Christian
Faithful Witnesses Spread the Good News

Devotional Reading: Psalm 86:1-10

Background Scripture: Acts 22:3-15

Printed Text: Acts 22:3-15

Key Verses: And he said: The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest know his will, and see that Just One, and shouldest hear the voice of his mouth. For thou shalt be his witness unto all men of what thou hast seen and heard. (Acts 22:14-15, KJV). The book of Acts is a picture of the early church in action. The book of Acts likely written in the 80s. The book of Acts is officially called "the Acts of the Apostles." It bridges the story of Jesus in the Gospel of Luke in the Church life. This book is well named, for it offers significant actions that help believers live out the meaning of what is involved in being a Christian. The book contains details of the formation and the spread of the church and the extension of the gospel within the apostolic generation. A key turning point happens with opposition from the religious hierarchy and Hellenistic Jews from outside Judea, especially after Stephen, one of the seven chosen to handle an internal conflict threatening the church's unity, is illegally stoned for a false accusation of blasphemy (Acts 6-7). Instead of stopping the movement, this opposition, led by a radical Pharisee named Saul. He later became known as Paul, turns out to be one of the most influential supporters of the Gospel of Jesus Christ after his conversion while traveling to persecute Christians in Syria. Paul defends himself against an accusation by Jews from Asia that he desecrated the temple by bringing Gentiles into it following his third missionary journey (Acts 21:27-22:29). Paul main argument in his defense is his undeniable Jewish heritage and his miraculous transformation from persecuting Christians to evangelizing Christ's message. Paul testified to his faith in Christ to convince Christians that he had truly repented of his former conviction and violent actions against believers.

Application for Activation

Our world is filled with division, injustice, and brokenness, yet Paul's story reminds us that God redeems unlikely people to bring healing. This week let us pray that God transforms ordinary live-in our church, community, and the word into instruments of justice and hope that challenge opposition and uplift the world.
