Who, Me?

The Early Ministry of Jeremiah
Unit Theme: Jeremiah and the Promise of Renewal

Devotional Reading: Jeremiah 1:11-19

Background Scripture: Jeremiah 1:1-13; 6:10-11; 8:18; 9:2; 26:1-24

Printed Text: Jeremiah 1:6-10; 26:8-9, 12-16

Key Verse: The LORD said unto me, Say not, I am a child: for thou shalt go to all that I shall send thee, and whatsoever I command thee thou shalt speak. (Jeremiah 1:7, JKV). When God called him, Jeremiah objected that he was "too young" to carry out the prophetic and yet, despite Jeremiah's reservations, God's sufficiency and purpose came to hear. Jeremiah's prophetic ministry began in 627 BC, about 70 years after Isaiah. He was a priest at Anathoth (Jeremiah 1:1), therefore from the tribe of Levi and an educated person. About this time, the last great Assyrian king died, ending the dominance of this cruel nation over the people of Israel. But other foreign menaces came to dominate Judah: first Egypt, then Babylon. This climaxed in 586 BC when the armies of Babylonian king Nebuchadnezzar captured Jerusalem and destroyed both the city walls and the temple (see 2 Kings 25:1, 8-11). Jeremiah's career spanned the reigns of the last five kings of Judah before this catastrophe. Jeremiah is known as the "Mournful Prophet." His name contributes to the English term "jeremiad," a bitter railing against opponents. He is credited as the author of the book that bears his name as well as the book of Lamentations. Jeremiah's bold proclamation in 26:12-15 directly challenged this institutional corruption, marking him as a dissenter in a volatile environment where false prophets proclaimed peace and prosperity while genuine divine warning called for repentance and radical social transformation. This principle demonstrates that effective ministry flows from God's enabling rather than human capability.

Application for Activation

Jeremiah's transformation from a hesitant youth to a courageous prophet demonstrates God's power to equip those He calls. God still calls modern believers to discern where God wants to speak truth in their spheres of influence. Like Jeremiah, we must trust God's enabling power rather than our abilities remembering that God's calling includes His equipping.

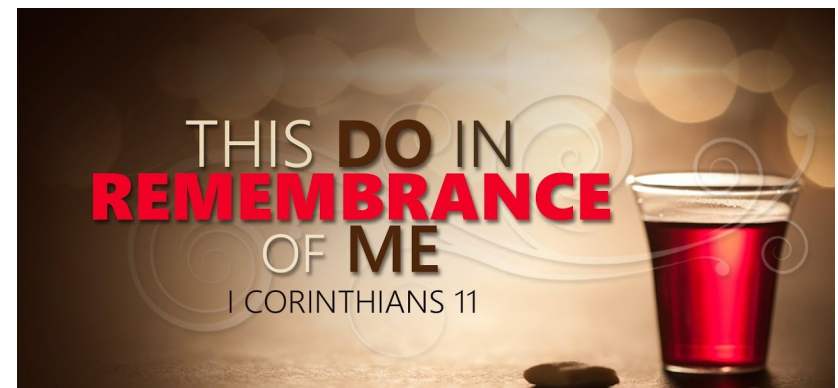
