Effecting Others with Our Decision

<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of this lesson is to make a plan and then acting upon the decision in a decision making strategy.

OBJECTIVE: Upon completion of this lesson, the participant will:

- 2. 100% of the time identify all persons effected/affected by their decisions.

PROCEDURE:

1. Read and consider the following:

Often we are not the only person(s) effected by our decisions. This can be anybody from family, friends, co-workers, and/or customers.

Sometimes the effects upon others are positive and of course sometimes the effects are negative. This is why when we make our decisions, we need to exercise empathy and consideration of others.

The way that others respond to our decisions and consequences of our decisions effects the outcome of our decisions. This ultimately effects us.
