Dear Union Vale Republican voters,

Early voting for the Republican Primary starts today, from 9 am-5 pm, and runs through June 23. Please check above for the times each site is open so you are not inconvenienced and please plan on voting!

It is imperative for the town that we choose Pat as our Republican candidate and **keep Pat Cartalemi on the Town Board!**

Your Republican Committee knows both these candidates very well and has endorsed Pat based on his intellect, his vast work experience with other municipalities around the State; his 8 years of experience on our Planning Board with 4 as the Chair; his current service on the Leadership Council for the State of New York for the *National Federation of Independent Business* (NFIB); his constant volunteer record with the town and his commitment to taking care of our town for the future. Pat is on the cutting edge of interesting business concepts and anything helpful for our Town he discovers will be brought to the Board's attention to discuss.

Pat has already shared with this town board, several money saving concepts which were already implemented to the benefit of the

taxpayers. We look forward to hearing more new ideas from Pat!

Alternatively, Pat's opponent, **Kevin Harrington**, has no applicable or current experience. He is **out of touch**. According to the Chairs at the time, he attended a few CAC meetings but never participated in the work. That was over 10 years ago. He was a member of the Historical Society but was rarely seen. Kevin is not an expert in municipal laws or town board member duties. He is not familiar with the town code or the financial requirements and duties of municipalities. His interest in running is based on doing someone a favor which is why residents and other committee members say he is **absolutely making deliberate, inaccurate statements about Pat Cartalemi** while he is out campaigning.

Kevin Harrington is a friend of Steve Frazier's and campaigned for him in 2023. As a reward, Steve appointed him Deputy Town Supervisor (Supervisor's are permitted to appoint a deputy). As Deputy, Kevin has no vote on the town board but can help out at town hall if Steve Frazier is away. Our concern lies in this comment made by the Supervisor to several people recently. Steve said "*when I get my friend on the Board, I will have the majority and will be able to do what I want*".

The Republican Committee is strongly against voting for any candidate with no municipal skills or applicable experience who's only purpose will be to vote along with a Supervisor, who has demonstrated his own lack of preparedness multiple times.

This is not good for the protection of and future of Union Vale. We can do better. We can hire smarts, experience and fairness.

Therefore, **we strongly urge you vote for Pat Cartalemi during this early voting period or on Primary day, June 25th.**
