**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S EX PARTE MOTION
FOR RECONSIDERATION OF SERVICE BY OTHER MEANS**

THIS CAUSE HAVING come before this Court on Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Motion for Reconsideration of Service by Other Means, and the Court having carefully reviewed the Motion and the record, and being otherwise fully informed of the matter, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:**

1. Plaintiff's Motion for Service by Other Means is **GRANTED**.
2. Pursuant to Chapter 48, Florida Statutes, Plaintiff may serve the Defendants through the method described in the Motion for Service by Other Means filed in this case.
3. Due to Defendants' scheme and their unknown locations, traditional methods of service are impracticable. An alternative method of service is necessary to provide actual notice under these circumstances and is consistent with Florida law.
4. Service shall be effectuated by executing a nominal-value blockchain transaction directed to each of the wallet addresses identified in Appendix A of the Complaint. The transaction will include a message embedded in the blockchain transaction data. This message will contain a hyperlink to a dedicated website maintained by Plaintiff's counsel, where the Complaint, Summons, and all other papers and Orders of this Court in this matter will be published and accessible to Defendants.

5. Upon service being effectuated, the Defendants shall have twenty (20) days to file a response to the Complaint.
