Psalm 23

- God is his shepherd and watches over him
- He makes him lie down

- And afterwards returned his body from the grave
- He is righteous
- Jesus was also between two raised things that is 2 thieves that were raised by his side
- He was covered by death as he died
- · God raised or stood him from death
- Something was prepared for him to be spread out on that is the cross in the presence of many people as God comforted and supported him
- God anointed him as Messiah
- No evil can ever before him any longer only good
- He dwells with God forever
