THE DISOBEDIENT PROPHET AS A TYPE OF CHRIST

- The disobedient prophet performed mighty works and a healing which the old prophet was aware of. Jesus performed mighty works and healings which the high priest was aware of.
- The disobedient prophet had a meal of food and drink shortly before his death. Jesus had a meal of bread and wine shortly before his death.
- The disobedient prophet was killed because of the lies and deception of the old prophet. Jesus was killed because of the lies and deception of the priests and false witnesses.
- The disobedient prophet was brought before the old prophet after reports of what he had done. Jesus was brought before the high priest after reports of what he had done.
- The old prophet asked the disobedient prophet who he was, and the disobedient prophet told him. The high priest asked Jesus who he was, and Jesus told him.
- The old prophet spoke about the disobedient prophet's death. The high priest spoke about Jesus's death.
- The disobedient prophet was killed outside the city with two (Lion and Ass) "standing" by his side (this is the same word used for crucifixion in the NT; perform a Greek word study of "crucify"). Jesus also was killed with 2 standing i.e. crucified by his side.
- The disobedient prophet was buried by the old prophet in the old prophet's own tomb.
 Jesus was busied by Joseph in Joseph's own tomb.
- A company of people saw the disobedient prophet dead with some animals standing (same word for crucify in NT) beside him. A company of people saw Jesus die with some crucified beside him.
- What had happened to the disobedient prophet was the spread by word of mouth. What
 happened to Jesus was then spread by preaching.
