

SOLOMON AS JESUS (PART 1)

Solomon

- Solomon was son of David and king of Israel
- In front of all the congregation of Israel he stood (same meaning as word crucify in NT) with his hands spread apart in order to make intercession for Israel and the nations (Strangers) for God to forgive sinners if they turn to God with all their heart
- Solomon acknowledges that all men are sinners
- The nations will hear, hence the strangers come to God
- He desires all the people both Jew and gentile to know and fear God
- He asks God to listen and do what we desire from God
- He then arose after his intercession
- He then declares that God be with them
- This will cause them to do righteousness
- After this, the people were joyful

Jesus

- Jesus was son of David and king of Israel
- In front of all the congregation of Israel he was crucified (stood) and died with his hands spread apart in order to make intercession for Israel and the nations (Strangers) for God to forgive sinners if they turn to God with all their heart
- Jesus says all men are sinners
- The nations hear, hence the foreigners come to God
- He desires all the people both Jew and gentile to know and fear God
- He asks God to listen and do what we desire from God
- He then arose from death after his intercession
- He then declares that God be with us via the Holy Spirit
- This will cause us to do righteousness
- After this, we become joyful
