

# ABIGAIL AS JESUS

## Abigail

- Note that because Nabal did not hearken to David, he and all his house were facing death i.e. because of one man, all were destined to die
- Abigail took upon herself sin which she wasn't responsible for
- She fell and lowered herself to the earth (The bible uses "to fall" as a synonym for death e.g. 2 Samuel 11:17; Exodus 32:28; Numbers 14:43; Psalms 82:7; 1 Samuel 18:25); also look up the word "ground" in a Hebrew concordance. You'll find out it also means earth
- She made intercession for the one who sinned and his household
- He tells Abigail to rise up (look up the word "go up" just like in the English, the word means to rise up or ascend)
- And he heard her prayer and accepted her intercession thus allowing Nabal and his household to live i.e. giving them continuing or eternal life.

## Jesus

- Note that because Adam did not hearken to God, he and all humans face death i.e. because of one man, all were destined to die
- Jesus took upon himself sin which he wasn't responsible for
- He died and was lowered into the heart of the earth
- He made intercession for all men
- he arose from his intercessory death i.e. resurrected
- God heard his prayer and accepted his intercession thus giving us eternal life
