

## ABIMELECH AS JESUS

### Abimelech

- One man brought sin upon all
- Abimelech was innocent yet he bore sin, brought upon him by Abraham, and God said he'll die and later he said he'll live
- In the morning the one who was dead and lived afterwards told his servants about what had happened i.e. his death and resurrection
- The servants then feared after they heard his message
- The one who was dead and lived then gives what he owns to the one who brought sin upon him
- His people then multiply by natural births
- Abimelech was king of the people i.e. Messiah

### Jesus

- Adam brought sin upon all
- Jesus was innocent yet he bore sin and God witnessed he died and lived again
- In the morning Jesus who was dead lived and afterwards told his servant ie the disciples about what happened to him
- Jesus gives what belongs to him (his kingdom, his spirit, his wisdom, his riches) to us who brought sin upon him
- The people of Jesus then multiply by spiritual births
- Jesus is King of the people i.e. Messiah
