DAVID AS JESUS (PART 1)

David

- Saul, who was a ruler, told his son and servant to kill David (the future King)
- · After this, David was hidden in a secret place
- Notice that from the narrative, David was sinless and innocent
- Saul then says that David who had made a great salvation for all his people, Israel, should live.
- David then returns to Saul's presence after hiding in a secret place for 3 days. (Please look up the Hebrew words of the text highlighted in orange in the Strong's concordance i.e. the phrase "in times past"

Jesus

- God and Pilate who were rulers, commanded their servants to kill Jesus (who was the future king or messiah)
- After the death of Jesus, he was hidden in the tomb
- Remember that Jesus was sinless and innocent
- God then commands that Jesus who made a great salvation for all his people (both jew and gentile) should be raised from death and live
- Jesus then returns to God after being hidden and buried for 3 days
