

## JERUSALEM AS JESUS (PART 1, EZEKIEL 16)

### Jerusalem

- Jerusalem was hated and cast out, being unclean and naked, to the field i.e. outside the city to die as she is in blood. Note that throughout the new testament, being unclean is a way of talking about being in sin
- Notice also that her blood is mixed with water as God washes away her blood
- She then lives and becomes great and crowned as the ruler of a kingdom, and multiplies via natural births
- Her name is published to the nations (i.e. heathen)

### Jesus

- Jesus was hated and cast out of the city being unclean i.e. carrying sin, and naked to die.
- As he died, his blood was mixed with water
- He then lives and becomes great and is crowned as king and multiplies his people via spiritual births.
- Jesus' name is then preached to the nations
