Samson

- Samson's mother was unable to give birth as she was barren, so it was announced to her by an angel that she'll give birth to a son
- The angel describes what the son will accomplish
- Samson was bound and given into the hands of the gentiles i.e. uncircumcised by the men of Judah (the word Judah is the same as Judas)
- In accomplishing his great deliverance for his people, he was thirsty
- The story gives the illusion that he died, because he said, "at this time I die for thirst" (look up the phrase in a Hebrew concordance)
- After dying, his spirit returns, and he lives again. (look up the word revived in the Hebrew concordance)
- He then ruled Israel i.e. his people.

- Jesus' mother was unable to give birth as she was a virgin, so it was announced to her by an angel that she'll give birth to a son
- The angel describes what Jesus will accomplish
- Jesus was bound and given into the hands of the gentiles by Judas
- In accomplishing his great deliverance for his people, he was thirsty
- Jesus died
- After dying, his spirit returned, and he lived again
- He then ruled his people (jew and gentile)
