

SAUL AS JESUS

Saul

- If you read verse 1, you'll see Saul was anointed with oil as the Messiah
- Saul went (and hid) in something prepared (look up the word "stuff")
- Some people ran to where he was hidden and saw him
- It was also proclaimed that the King lives after he had come out from hiding in the thing prepared (look up the meaning of the phrase "God save the king")
- As we can see as well, he then became the king of Israel because God had chosen him
- It is also witnessed that he is unique as "there is no one like him"
- Some people who God touches their heart follow Saul while the rest believe he isn't their saviour i.e. he can't save them

Jesus

- Jesus is the Messiah

- He then became king of Israel (i.e. of both the Jew and the nations or gentiles) because God had chosen him to be that
- As we know, Jesus is unique, and none is like him
