- Joseph's brothers were given gifts for their father.
- Jesus's disciples were given gifts for the gentiles.
- Joseph called for unity among the brothers.
- Jesus called for unity among the disciples.

- Jesus's disciples left the land to go and call the gentiles from other lands.
