- God was with him through the Holy Spirit
- Jesus died
- He talked to God while dying as he was troubled
- He was the son of David
- God heard his prayer and destined him to rise on the third day
- God saved both Jesus and his people
- Jesus who was dead then Lived
- People from distant countries, i.e., the nations, hear about Jesus's death and resurrection on the third day

- They then come to Jesus who shows them all he has
- God promises that one day, all Jesus has will be given to them
- This is good in the sight of Jesus
