Sequence of events instead of sequence of the text

John the Baptist

- Herodias quarrelled with John
- She wanted to kill him but could not
- John was righteous i.e. just, and holy
- Herodias incited her daughter to ask for John to be put to death
- The king didn't want to but did for the sake of rulers
- The king ordered and killed John
- His disciples were aware of his death and took his body and buried him in a tomb
- John was risen from the dead (what the narrative portrays though he didn't rise)
- Preaching about John was then spread abroad
- Herod said this because of the mighty works done

Jesus

- The leaders of the Jews quarrelled with Jesus
- They wanted to kill him for a while but couldn't
- Jesus was righteous and holy
- The leaders incited the masses to ask for Jesus to be put to death
- Pilate (a ruler like a king) didn't want to but did for the sake of offending Caesar a ruler
- Pilate ordered and killed Jesus
- His disciples were aware of his death and took his body and buried him in a tomb
- Jesus rose from the dead
- Preaching about Jesus was then spread abroad
- Mighty works are done by Jesus
