

## SAUL AS JESUS PART 2

### Saul

- Saul came with 2 men, so what is about to happen is to Saul happens to him with 2 men by him
- Saul was distressed and tells us God had departed from him i.e. forsaken him
- All this trouble Saul faces is because he had mercy on Amalek (who God calls sinners in 1 Samuel 15) and let them live while they were destined to die from the wrath of God i.e., he gave them continuation of life
- Saul was strengthless and fell to the earth (The bible uses "to fall" as a synonym for death e.g. 2 Samuel 11:17; Exodus 32:28; Numbers 14:43; Psalms 82:7; 1 Samuel 18:25)
- He then arose from the earth
- His kingdom was given to his servant David

### Jesus

- Jesus came with two men by him
- He was distressed and says God had forsaken him, i.e. departed from him
- Jesus faces all this distress because he had mercy on us sinners who were destined to die under God's wrath but instead let us live i.e. gave us eternal or continuation of life
- Jesus was strengthless (as he was strengthened by an angel) and he died and went into the earth
- He then arose i.e. resurrected
- His kingdom is given to his servants, us
