Ebenezer Quilt Pattern

48 inches by 60 inches

FABRIC

1 ½ yards for 6 ½" square blocks

• 1 yard each of two different colors of fabric for four patch blocks

CUTTING

6 1/2" square block: Cut seven 6 1/2" wide strips by width of fabric, then cut strips into

6 1/2" square blocks

Four Patch:

Cut seven 3 1/2" wide strips by width of fabric of each color

SEWING

Sew two of the 3 1/2" wide (one of each color) strips together, press seam to one side. Sew the remained of the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together as per instructions above. These strips will be 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide, cut the strips into blocks that are 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Sew the blocks together to make four patches that are 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew the blocks together using the pattern as a guide.
