A		41722-1 Navy	1	(2) 4-1/2" x 42" strips. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips and (2) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. (6) 3-1/2" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips and (2) 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips.






Subcut (2) 2-1/4" x 48-1/2" strips and (2) 2-1/4" x 43" strips. (6) 3" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 3" x 54-1/2" strips and (2) 3" x 50-1/2" strips. (3) 2" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2" x 48-1/2" strips. Three 4-1/2" x 42" strips. Subcut (24) 4-1/2" squares.

UNIT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the M 4-1/2" squares.
- **2.** Place a marked square, right sides together, on one end of (1) K 4-1/2" \times 8-1/2" piece. Sew on the drawn line, trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " past the drawn line, and press open. Repeat on the opposite end of the **K** piece to make a flying geese unit. Make (4) **KM** units.











3. Repeat step 2 to make (4) HM units, (4) IM units, (4) KM units and (4) JM units.







QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Arrange and sew together the labeled pieces to make the pieced left column and pieced right column.

- (1) M 1.5" x 20.5" piece

- (1) **G** 2.5" x 20.5" piece (1) **M** 1.5" x 20.5" piece
- (1) **A** 4.5" x 20.5" piece

- (1) **D** 4.5" x 20.5" piece
- (1) M 1.5" x 20.5" piece

- 5. Arrange the (16) flying geese units as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram to make the middle column. Sew (1) M 2" x 48-1/2" strip to each long side of the flying geese column. Sew the pieced left column and pieced right column to opposite sides of the flying geese column.
- 6. M BORDER #1: Sew (2) M 2-1/4" x 48-1/2" strips to opposite long sides of the guilt center. Sew (2) M 2-1/4" x 43" strips to the top and bottom.
- **7. H BORDER:** Sew (2) **H** 1-3/4" \times 52" strips to opposite long sides of the quilt. Sew (2) **H** 1-3/4" \times 45-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
- **8. M BORDER #2:** Sew (2) **M** $3'' \times 54-1/2''$ strips to opposite long sides of the quilt. Sew (2) **M** $3'' \times 50-1/2''$ strips to the top and bottom.
- 9. A BORDER: Sew (2) A 3-1/2" x 59-1/2" strips to opposite long sides of the quilt. Sew (2) A 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.





FINISHING

Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using \mathbf{L} 2-1/4" x 42" strips.
