Malfunctioning Legislature: A Threat to Good Governance and the Will of the People

As we move forward from the November elections, it's crucial that we turn our attention to how our local and state governments are operating. Specifically, we must ensure that control over our communities remains in the hands of the people, not dominated by lawmakers in Sacramento. With 62 Democrats and 17 Republicans in the Assembly (with one vacant seat), the dangerous imbalance of one-party rule has resulted in Democrats making decisions unilaterally, often disregarding the voices of voters.

This is no trivial matter—it is not representation. We, the people, must regain control over the progress and direction of our communities and resist the unchecked governance coming from Sacramento.

The situation in California is alarming. The recent propositions on the ballot reflect continued borrowing by Democrats, placing the burden of debt squarely on the backs of homeowners for years to come. And it is intentional. Consider the implications if California's financial collapse were to ripple across the country. This is a matter of grave concern for the entire nation.

The erosion of local government control is perhaps most evident in the numerous housing bills passed in recent years, which jeopardize the quality of life in California communities. This "one-size-fits-all" approach to housing ignores the unique needs and circumstances of each community.

Thankfully, *Our Neighborhood Voices* (ONV) is stepping up as a key advocate for affordable, appropriate housing in California. A grassroots coalition of neighbors and local leaders with over 25,000 supporters statewide, ONV advocates for housing that is affordable for middle, working, and lower-income Californians, while also being tailored to fit the character of each community. Their vision includes collaboration between neighbors, developers, business owners, and local officials—an approach that respects democracy and local input.

In stark contrast, recent state laws have undermined and disenfranchised millions of Californians. The political establishment, fueled by millions in donations, has empowered developers to build whatever, wherever, and however they please, regardless of local needs. This leaves residents and their representatives without a voice. These laws disproportionately target suburbs and single-family communities, and ONV is leading the charge to fight back against this undemocratic overreach.

I am particularly disturbed by the state's ongoing efforts to "stack and pack," densifying established residential neighborhoods without sufficient local input. This top-down approach neglects the voices of the people when significant changes are being imposed on our communities.

To make matters worse, Governor Gavin Newsom has recently signed legislation that increases the state attorney general's power to fine cities that fail to comply with state housing laws. Under current law, the attorney general must sue non-compliant cities, and penalties only start accruing months, or sometimes years, after a ruling. However, once Senate Bill 1037 goes into effect, fines can be retroactively assessed from the date the violation began, with the revenue directed toward building affordable housing in the penalized jurisdiction.

This is yet another instance of the state tightening its grip on local governance.

We, the people, are losing control of our destiny. We must unite to save our communities, and in doing so, save our families. Local issues require local solutions—not mandates handed down by a few who seem intent on undermining our trust and consolidating power. We must reclaim that power and return it to the hands of the people, where it belongs.



United Sovereign Americans

If you haven't heard of United Sovereign Americans (USA) please take the time to visit their website united4freedom.com. It's a group of volunteers strictly focused on election integrity that has found so many irregularities throughout the country, it's terrifying.

USA has filed nine federal civil rights lawsuits on behalf of American citizens. Their analysis has measured the effect of election misconduct, and their litigation strategy has pre-positioned standing for the American people in advance of the 2024 election. Article II of the Constitution Establishes the Executive Branch & the Electoral College (How does that work?): Lesson IV

(Continued from last month's edition)

This month we continue with Article II of the U.S. Constitution - the establishment of the executive branch. Last month we took the time to examine the importance of the electoral college, and how and why the Framers established the method of choosing the executive. Just a reminder - the Articles of Confederation, which the Framers were seeking to replace (rather than repair, as was their mandate) lacked a single, decision-making executive, which put the confederation at risk when military action could not be made swiftly. It would be impossible, for example, to make a timely military decision in legislative chambers with deliberation. We also need to keep in mind that the young country had just fought a war to extricate themselves from a king. Madison, however, in Federalist 51 explains that although "[i]n republican government the legislative authority necessarily predominates" and "[a] s the weight of the legislative authority requires that it be divided [into the House and the Senate], the weakness of the executive [branch] may require, on the other hand, that it should be fortified."

Indeed, fortify it they did, however cautiously. Article II includes a check on executive power with the legislative power of overriding a veto, the requirement of Advice & Consent of the Senate for federally appointed officials and judges and the congressional power of impeachment, coupled with the senatorial power of removal from office. Constitutional scholars acknowledge two types of powers granted to the president, the Express Powers – those listed in Art. II, and the Inherent Powers (powers that are inferred, that is to say, powers necessary to fulfill the duties of an executive).

Express powers:

- Military —— Sec. 2 Commander and Chief
- Judicial—— Sec. 2 Grant pardons
- Diplomatic Sec. 3 Receive foreign ambassadors
- Executive Sec. 2 Appoint Executive officers and federal judges;
 Sec. 3 Carry out laws
- Convene Congress In the face of emergencies
- Veto legislation

The president has traditionally had the power of Executive Orders,

which is a power that was little used in profusion until the Obama Administration. An executive order is a unilateral directive that holds the weight of law, but which is temporary and can be readily negated by the succeeding president. Likely the most infamous executive order is Executive Order 9066, signed on February 19, 1942, by Franklin D. Roosevelt, authorizing the removal of Japanese Americans into detainment camps during WWII. Another well-known Executive Order is President Obama's answer to "The Dream Act" not passing in congress in 2007 nor again when reintroduced and failing to pass yet a second time in 2011. The Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) was an Executive Order signed by President Obama on June 15, 2012.

Why did President Trump negate DACA? Because he promised during his campaign that he would promote comprehensive immigration reform and he warned both houses, as Obama himself had done, that he would pressure the legislative branch to follow through and establish a path to citizenship for those who had been brought into the U.S. illegally by their parents as children. A law establishing a path to citizenship would be almost impossible to rescind, which Trump explained over and over to no avail. He was doing DACA recipients a favor by pressuring congress to pass immigration reform, but the media portrayed it otherwise and Biden re-established DACA soon after his inauguration.

The Executive Branch is by far the most complex and largest part of American government, although the enormity of the vast bureaucracy that employs over two million people is not what the Founders intended. The Framers held that the people delegated their authority to the House and Senate, but today under the fifteen presidential cabinet secretaries are fifteen agencies and sub-agencies that hold enormous regulatory power over the American people, their businesses, federal lands, etc., without accountability to the voters. How big is this behemoth, often referred to as "The Administrative State"? See this diagram of the executive branch!

How did the executive branch get so absurdly huge? Franklin Delano Roosevelt, the longest serving president in American history (holding office from 1933 until his death in 1945) was not a man to let a good crisis go to waste. FDR assumed powers he thought necessary to win the war and employed those powers as an opportunity to expand not only the power and importance of the president but also to expand the scope and intrusive nature of government. He established the Executive Office of the President in 1939, which includes: The National Security Council, The Council of Economic Advisers, the Office of Budget and Management, the U.S. Trade Representative and the Office of the Vice President. Nearly every president since FDR has sought to expand his powers, with perhaps the exception of Ronald Reagan and Donald Trump.
