The Institute for Cyber Executive Education (“the Institute,” “we,” “our,” or “us”) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting the personal information you provide when visiting our website.

This Privacy Policy describes how information is collected, used, and protected when you access or interact with the Institute’s website.

Information We Collect

Information You Provide Voluntarily

We may collect personal information that you voluntarily provide through the website, including when you:

- submit a contact form
- request an executive briefing
- download a program prospectus
- inquire about Institute programs
- register interest in courses or events

This information may include:

- name
- email address
- organization
- professional title
- other information you choose to provide

We collect only the information necessary to respond to your request or provide program information.

Automatically Collected Information

When you visit the website, certain information may be collected automatically through standard website technologies, including:

- IP address
- browser type
- device information
- pages visited
- referring website
- date and time of access

This information helps us understand how visitors use the site and improve the website experience.

How We Use Information

Information collected through the website may be used to:

- respond to inquiries
- provide information about Institute programs
- deliver requested materials such as program prospectuses
- communicate regarding executive education offerings
- improve website functionality and user experience
- maintain the security and integrity of the website

The Institute does **not sell personal information** to third parties.

Cookies and Analytics

The website may use cookies or similar technologies to enhance user experience and support website analytics.

These technologies may collect anonymous information about how visitors interact with the website, such as:

- pages viewed
- time spent on the site
- navigation paths

You may disable cookies through your browser settings if you prefer not to allow their use.

Third-Party Services

The website may use trusted third-party services to support website functionality, such as:

- website hosting platforms
- analytics tools
- form processing tools
- email communication services

These service providers may have access to limited information necessary to perform their services but are expected to handle information in accordance with applicable privacy standards.

Data Security

The Institute takes reasonable measures to protect information submitted through the website from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.

However, no internet transmission can be guaranteed to be completely secure, and users provide information at their own discretion.
