For my Treasurers report this month I thought I would do a recap of the 2022 fundraisers for the first 6 months of this year. In our budget we have projected a fundraiser income of \$5000.00 for the year. For the first 6 months of the year, we have raised \$2042.00.

These funds were raised from: Recycling- \$271.00 Pancake Breakfast - \$1217.00 Parking - \$70.00 Turkey in the Barrel- \$435.00 Misc- \$50.00

First Congregational United Church of Christ Celebrates Gift of Organ

On Sunday, July 10, a dedicatory organ concert was held at First Congregational United Church of Christ in Murphys CA to a packed crowd. The church recently received the organ as a gift from the Don and Mary Jean Bissell family.


In 2000, Donald and Mary Jean Bissell set up a trust for the sole purpose of donating to organizations they supported and loved. They were excellent role models of participation and held many officer positions in our congregation. First Congregational UCC is one of the happy recipients of their generous gift. The children and grandchildren continued this legacy of generous giving as they passed the trust proceeds to our church. Don and Mary Jean's love for music and the church was evidenced by the loyal service in the ministry and music of the church and community. They were avid supporters of the Bear Valley Music Festival as well.

Dr. Daryl Hollinger, the Director of Music at First
Congregational United Church of Christ and the Director of the
Columbia College Community Chorus presented delightful and
varied repertoire which charmed the audience of all ages. A 28
voice Celebration Choir performed Dr. Hollinger's composition,
Sing to the Lord, which showcased the diverse tonal palette of
the new organ. He is a world-renowned organist and gives
private vocal, piano and organ lessons. He has set up a
scholarship fund for students wishing to learn how to play the
organ.

The Rodgers Imagine Series 235 delivers the most stunning sounds available in digital organs in a beautiful 2-manual instrument. The organ has a total of 217 voices spread across 4 unique organ styles: American Eclectic, English Cathedral, French Romantic and German Baroque. On top of that, the organ features 28 premium orchestral voices. With 35 main stops, and the additional 99 Voice Palette stops, the Imagine 235 allows the organist to discover new possibilities.

A highly experienced and diverse group of organ specialists, audio professionals, and engineers, developed the Imagine Series with only one goal in mind: to create an unparalleled experience, both for the organist and the audience. The Imagine Series is perfect for leading congregational singing, while also shining as a solo instrument for churches, institutions, and symphony orchestras. The Imagine Series pushes musical creativity to new horizons.

The church plans to hold an annual organ concert open to the community.









My name is Caity Johnson. I have lived in Murphys, CA my entire life. I have attended First Congregational Church in Murphys since I was a young child and I am a 6th generation Murphys resident. I have had a dream of working as a baker/chef/pastry chef for as long as I can remember. I have been baking most of my life. I remember sitting on the counter helping my mother bake cookies at 3 years old. I would help my grandmother make cookies, and my mom showed me how to make bread. I went through a phase of making French bread on the weekends for quite a few months.

In order to realize my dream of becoming a Pastry Chef, I enrolled in an on-line training program in August of 2021. The name of the school is Augusta Escoffier School of Culinary Arts. I have completed 10 courses, both in pastry arts and in business. I have a GPA of 3.75 and am proud to say I have made the Honor Roll and the Presidents list every semester. I have 3 more classes to complete prior to graduating.

In addition to the coursework, I am required to do a 6-week internship to qualify for graduation. The internship must be done at a French bakery. There are no qualifying bakeries nearby, or in any of the foothill counties. I have been very fortunate and am proud to announce that I was able to find a position at the Dessert European Bakery in Modesto. The internship is scheduled to begin in late September; the work will be 6 days per week, approximately 5 hours per day. When I complete the internship, I will qualify to graduate from the program on November 8, 2022.

The internship is completely unpaid. I am seeking a scholarship of \$2,000 to enable me to live in Modesto for 6 weeks to do my internship. Because of my recent back surgery and another unrelated hospitalization, I was out of work for 4 months and have depleted my savings. I've been fortunate to find a reasonably priced living situation in Modesto, but I will need help with the rent. My family and I feel we can cover all other expenses of my stay. I have checked with several local Murphys organizations, and none have scholarship funds available at this time. With the skills that I will have attained upon graduation, I hope to open my own bakery at some point. I love doing pastries and complicated desserts.

I am grateful to have you consider me for a scholarship. This would be so very meaningful for my future.






