








Let us extend our warmest welcome to Reverend Dr.

Vice-Moderator's Musings

Well, we have taken an important step in our transition. Our interim pastor, Reverend Gary Percesepe, will be joining us this month. In addition to providing the usual pastoral duties, an interim pastor also has the task of guiding and challenging us to examine who we are, and who God is calling us to become. As a part of

this process, Gary will be assisting us in completing our parish profile. Actually, each one of us has this as an important task for the next few months.

At least half of us have not gone through the UCC process of selecting a new pastor previously, so I'd like to explain the purpose of the parish profile in this process. This document should be used for our church to discover and tell its story to ministers who are searching for a new pastorate. It is valuable in exploring our future direction by answering three questions: Who are we now? Who is our neighbor? Who is God calling us to become? UCC provides us with a discovery document that provides prompts to stimulate our discussion, exploration and storytelling. So our first step is to decide how to involve the congregation and our supporting community to obtain this information from all of you. We can use our existing small groups, or we can call special meetings for this specific purpose, use surveys, or select other methods to gather this data. Let us hear from you.
