Blessings to all as we traverse this time of change and ask the Lord to be with us each and every step of the way.



Please attend the Congregational Meeting on June 22. I will be presenting a new revised Endowment Policy and also will be requesting a Budget Revision. These documents will be sent to

you before the meeting for you to review. Pastor Bonnie, Barbara, and I worked hard on the Endowment policy to include up to date language and we also consulted with UC Funds to include appropriate language for the policy. Please review and let me know if you have any questions. The Budget revision is necessary since salary figures were incorrect and there are many unknowns during this transitional period. Finance and Facilities and the Council have approved increasing pay for the Pastor substitute and also the music substitutes which currently is not reflected in the budget.
