

Moderator's Message

Welcome Spring! I think we're all wanting to welcome spring now, though we can certainly use the early April rain. I know some of you may be wondering how the pastoral search is going, especially now that Pastor Bonnie and Dr. Daryl's departures are looming ever closer!

The Pastoral Search team is composed of: Barbara Olivier, Judy Regalia, Penny Sarvis, Mark McCormick, Tami Chesnut, Carrie Shinn and Noel Helmbrecht. We have been trying to meet every Tuesday morning via Zoom, though we have skipped some weeks as there's not a whole lot we

can accomplish right now.

The team has put together a job description and compensation package for an Interim Pastor. We have been told to expect to have an interim Pastor with us for 12-18 months while we search for, and interview settled Pastor candidates. However, none of these moves can be made until we have an interim Pastor.

The NCNC office tells us that the interim Pastor needs to be qualified for this specific role in the UCC denomination, and this individual will guide us through the transition after Pastor Bonnie departs, help us to put together the Church Profile that will go out to candidates, and fulfill all other Pastoral roles while the search is taking place. Rev Davena at NCNC is searching for the perfect individual for this role, as she has a good understanding of our church. The NCNC has also posted the Interim position on the NCNC and UCC web sites, so we are hoping to start receiving some candidate applications soon. Rev Davena is telling us that our requirement for the interim pastor to live within Calaveras County for the duration may make it a little more difficult to find an Interim.

We should probably be prepared for a mixture of Pastors conducting worship in June, and maybe into July. The search team is putting out feelers to various folks to preach (of course our beloved Mickey and Penny are at the top of the list!), as we just aren't sure exactly when an interim Pastor will join us. We are all a bit frustrated with the time that has elapsed since Bonnie and Daryl announced their retirement date, but we are doing the best we can!

The personnel team, led by Barb Olivier, is actively working on filling the music director position. They have created a job description and it's being circulated.

Please pray for us as we actively work on these very important tasks. And feel free to ask any of us any questions you might have during this process.
