
in the Community Clean up event at Murphys cemetery, and are planning a fun activity for later in May.

In addition to providing the usual pastoral duties of preaching, leading the worship services, supporting the lay leadership, and providing pastoral care, an interim pastor also guides and challenges the church members to examine who we are, and who God is calling us to become. This process helps us to discover what attributes are needed and desired in our next pastor.

I am pleased to inform you that our committee has received information regarding one candidate for the interim pastor, and we understand that there is one additional candidate who is preparing paperwork for us. Unfortunately, there is a significant lack of qualified ministers seeking a new position. Fortunately, we only need to find one that is fitting for our congregation. It is our goal to bring an interim pastor to our church as soon as possible. In the meantime, we have made arrangements with our members who are retired pastors to assist with both worship services and pastoral care for the short term. We do ask that you keep our work in your prayers. Thank you!



## Strengthen the Church Offering June 8


