PROCEDURES FOR RESERVING OAK BOWER

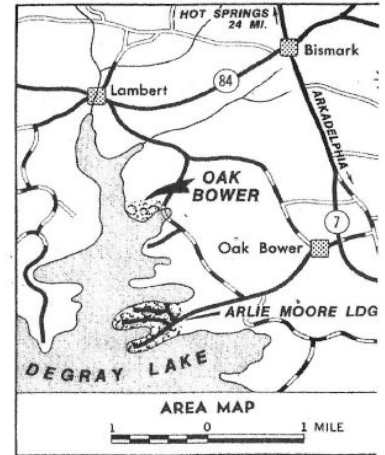
1. Obtain reservation permit form from the Office/Visitors Center, DeGray Lake.
2. Complete and return the permit form to the office for approval or disapproval by the Park Manager.
3. A deposit fee equal to no less than one day's use must accompany the request. This deposit will be applied toward total rental fee.
4. A reservation request should be made at least two weeks in advance of actual use date.
5. Minimum size of group: 20 persons
6. Maximum length of stay: 7 days

ITEMS GROUPS WILL NEED

1. Food
2. Sleeping apparel, including bedrolls, air mattresses, pillows and blankets.
3. Cookware, dishwashing soap, plates, glasses and dishes.
4. Lawn chairs, flashlights, first aid kit and radios.

FURNISHED BY THE CORPS

1. Six sleeping shelters (7 bunks each) with heat and air conditioning units.
2. Dining Hall and a separate Kitchen Cabin with heat and air conditioning units.
3. Restrooms and showers.
4. Drinking fountain.
5. Jug filler fountains.
6. Group size fire ring.
