

At this time, I would like to thank Grandmaster H.K. Lee, who, even with his very busy schedule, made time to interview with us

today! Also, I am very confident that what he is about to share with us can give so much benefit to many TaeKwonDo families!

MAWN: Grandmaster Lee, why did you choose to come to the USA and how long have you been in the USA?

HKL: As you know, the USA has the most opportunity and is the fairest country. Also, I really appreciate this country. I was born in April. 1947, two years after Korea's independence from Japanese

occupation and three years before the Korean Civil War. Without the sacrifices of the United States and the World Freedom Fighters, I might not be here today and all of Korea would be ruled by communist dictators.

be humble and gentle to become a respectable individual.

3rd: practice speed and proper timing for everyday life, when and how fast and the right time to take actions.

4th: practice cooperating while performing offense and defense with one's partner to help improve each other's selfdefense. Expand this idea to become a great servant for others in our society.

So for the last 46 years, while I am giving TaeKwonDo instruction, I have been promoting the true meaning of TaeKwonDo, and at the same time, even if it's a small thing, I believe I returned many favors to the USA!

5th: teaching the use of precision techniques and proper use of timing for better self-defense. Build habits of taking the right actions, at the right time.

6th: teaching how to take proper actions from different directions for defense and offense to learn how

> and where to stand. Apply this to daily life to establish clear guidelines while performing different tasks.

Of course, there are many other ways where TaeKwonDo action philosophy can be applied to daily life. These are just a few examples.

> States America is very different from 50 years ago right before you came to the USA. What do you think about America today?

HKL: When I was in Korea I thought that Americans are the most polite, well dressed, and disciplined people in the world because I saw all of them showing lots of confidence through saying "Sir"

or "Ma'am" to each others. shaking hands with warm smiles, as well as taking care of all the needy people, etc. But I think today our young people have become too casual with health, dress and language, and they are losing lots of self-discipline as well as confidence!

MAWN: How do you think we

MAWN: What do you mean by returning favors to the USA through TaeKwonDo instruction?

HKL: Because of what I taught to our community through Tae-KwonDo instruction. First of all, I have mentored good character and citizenship, such as humility, respect, self-discipline, patience and care for others, to accomplish greater things in students' lives and make a difference in the world. I have also promoted healthy minds and bodies while teaching selfdefense skills that build confidence and freedom from

can improve and reinforce positive traditional values?

HKL: Take TaeKwonDo classes! You will realize TaeKwonDo is an action philosophy as described above! TaeKwonDo practice will give you all of those answers!

MAWN: I can see why all around the world TaeKwonDo practitioners highly respect you! Would you mind giving some advice to all our TaeKwonDo practitioners around the world?

HKL: I am sharing what I practice daily and try to follow these famous wise remarks...with my humble advice:

"Always bear in mind that your own resolution to succeed is more important than any one thing." (Abraham Lincoln)

"Success is not final, failure is not fatal, it is the courage to continue that counts" (Winston Churchill)

"Success is simple, do what's right, the right way, at the right time" (Arnold Glasgow) $\,$

"Superior technique is realized through a strong desire to

achieve your goals!" H.K. Lee (unknown original author)


"Dreams come not by thinking and wishing, but from hard work and earnest effort." H.K. Lee (unknown original author!)

MAWN: Do you mind giving us some advice on how to follow these examples?

HKL: Of course, first, I would like to suggest to everyone, if you want to become experts at anything, you must practice repeatedly over and over again until that becomes your second nature! You can make your dream a reality!

MAWN: Lastly, I hear that you are organizing a 2022 USA Kukkiwon Expo in your area! Would you like to explain to us what that is about and why you decided to host this big event?

HKL: first, to promote the authentic martial art, Kukkiwon TaeKwonDo, through the Expo!

When Kukkiwon President Dongsup Lee stopped by my dojang for a short greeting visit, he shared with me about his trip to the USA, on his way home to Korea (after presenting an honorary black belt to Donald Trump, former president of the USA).

At that time he thoughtfully expressed how he wanted to have some of the biggest Kukkiwon events at the hub and world capital - Washington, DC. He asked me to thoroughly research the possibilities. Then,

if possible, he said he would like to humbly request that I would consider organizing the Kukkiwon Presidents Cup TaeKwonDo Championship in Washington, DC!

At first I was very hesitant because the preparation time was too short, as well as I considered that I may be too old to be con-

So after much consideration of how we may have to sacrifice a lot of time and money, we decided to rent a 1st class arena for future reference, social standing and the reputation of Kukkiwon as well as the globalization of Kukkiwon TaeKwonDo!

Master JC Thomas grew up at our TaekwonDo Academy since he was six years old and now he's a 40 year old professional classroom teacher in Fairfax County Public Schools and still makes time to come into the dojang to help me teach students! He was a Virginia State Champion many times and is a 6th degree Black belt.

Master Krishna Balal is a 7th degree Black Belt, former President of Nepal ITF, and currently Head Instructor and Senior Master at H.K. Lee Academy of TaekwonDo!
