

## CARE & MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

Please follow the guidelines listed below to ensure the proper cure, protection, and long-term durability of your freshly refinished bathtub, vanity top, or kitchen countertop surface.

### CLEANING RECOMMENDATIONS

Due to the high-gloss, non-porous surface structure of your new finish, there is no need to ever use heavy scrubbing mechanics or abrasive cleaning powders. Standard, non-abrasive liquid household detergents will yield excellent results while preserving the mirror-like shine.

#### ✓ Recommended Cleaning Products

- Dawn® (Liquid Dish Soap)
- Lysol® Basin, Tub & Tile Cleaner
- Scrubbing Bubbles® (Non-Abrasive)
- Mr. Clean® (Liquid Multi-Surface)
- Formula 409® (Strictly without bleach)

#### ✗ Prohibited Surface Actions (DONT'S)

- **Do not use** the newly refinished surface for at least **24 hours**.
- **Do not use abrasive tools:** Avoid S.O.S.® pads, Comet®, Ajax®, Soft Scrub®, or steel wool.
- **Do not use** harsh chemicals containing Bleach.
- **Do not use** bathmats with suction cups underneath.
- **Do not drop** heavy, sharp, or harsh objects onto the finish.
- **No cutting** on countertops or placing hot objects directly down.

### CRUCIAL SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

**Leaking Plumbing & Faucets:** Continuous water dripping will erode and destroy the refinished coating layers prematurely. Any leaking or dripping faucets within the refinished zone must be immediately repaired by the owner to protect the structural integrity of the finish. Dropping items or sliding sharp cookware across countertops can cause localized peeling, chipping, or deep cracks that are not covered under basic application parameters.
