She will bring samples of her work, papers she uses and will demonstrate how to create surface designs.

Laura is an Abstract Mixed Media Collage Artist. She teaches collage with the "heat seal iron" method, fusing coated collage papers to many surfaces. She has

taught many classes and workshops in Illinois, Michigan, and Wisconsin, she also currently teaches online classes. Laura is a National Award Winner and National Collage Society Signature member and co-founder of the Midwest Collage Society in which she is also a member. As a self-taught artist, Laura has been working in the medium of hand papermaking and collage for 30 years. She primarily focuses on composition, layering, color and ability to create depth in her collage artwork. Her works have been published in many books by North
