### **Scholarships and Eligibility**

This scholarship may only be awarded to the same applicant a maximum of two times. Persons having been awarded this scholarship more than once are no longer eligible to apply or receive this scholarship.

- One \$1,000.00 scholarship and two \$500.00 scholarships are available to residents of the Village of Romeoville pursuing a degree in public service (law enforcement, police officer, forensic sciences, firefighter, paramedic, teacher, nurse, or doctor).
- **2.** One \$500.00 scholarship is available to a Lodge 15 member in good standing, or their immediate family member, pursuing any Associate or Bachelor degree.


#### **Questionnaire**
