A little holiday history...

This holiday season is a very special one. Most of us will remember the holiday season of 2020 compared to 2021 as not a joyful one. Last year, we were told not to have the usual Christmas family gathering due to the Coronavirus. This year, we were able to enjoy Thanksgiving and now Christmas and Hanukkah with our family. What a difference!

Do you have any idea why we celebrate Christmas on December 25th? Well, there are two theories and I will give you part of the theories.

The first: people and religions celebrated some sort of holiday at that time, from Jewish Hanukkah to Pagan Winter Solstice to Germanic Yule. The sheer number of celebration days with trees, decorations, Yule logs, mistletoe and feasts seemed to point to a season of celebration, to which Christians added the birth of Jesus as a countercultural event and possibly even an escape from the pagan holidays for the early believer.

The second theory centers around the date accepted by the Western Church of March 25th as the Immaculate Conception of Jesus in Mary's womb. December 25th is nine months later, and thus celebrated as the birthday of Jesus.

Regardless of the possible reasons for the date, the Church calendar was set in the West during Constantine's reign, while the Eastern Church held on to January for some time.

Hanukkah, one of the most widely celebrated Jewish festivals, is a festive eight-day celebration that for many people falls during the darkest, coldest season of the year. Hanukkah is also called the Festival of Lights. The holiday brings light, joy, and warmth to the homes and communities as they celebrate with candles, food, family, and friends. Light comes literally from the lighting of a candle on the menorah each evening for eight nights. Included in the lighting is singing and playing special songs and games followed by special foods of the holiday. My favorite is potato latkes (potato pancakes) and bimuelos (fried dough puffs).






