Overview

Your FC Closets system is built using high-quality **melamine materials** designed for long-lasting durability, easy maintenance, and resistance to scratches, stains, and everyday wear.

With proper care, your custom closets and cabinetry will continue to look and function beautifully for years to come.

Daily Cleaning

- **Dust regularly** using a soft, dry microfiber cloth or feather duster.
- For light dirt or fingerprints, wipe with a damp, non-abrasive cloth and mild dish soap diluted in warm water.
- Wipe dry immediately with a clean, lint-free towel to prevent moisture buildup along edges and seams.

Deep Cleaning (As Needed)

- 1. Mix a few drops of **mild dish detergent** with warm water.
- 2. Dampen a soft cloth never soak it.
- 3. Wipe surfaces gently, following the grain or direction of the laminate finish.
- 4. Dry completely using a soft towel.
- 5. For stubborn spots (like grease or adhesive residue), apply a small amount of **isopropyl alcohol (70%)** to a soft cloth, wipe gently, and immediately follow with a clean, damp cloth to remove any residue.
- 6. In the event none of the above work, Magic Eraser will do the trick.

What to Avoid

To maintain the integrity and appearance of your melamine surfaces, **do not use**:

- Abrasive pads, scouring powders, or steel wool
- Harsh cleaners containing bleach, ammonia, or acetone
- Wax-based or oil-based polishes
- Steam cleaners or high-pressure sprayers
- Excessive water or soaking, especially near seams and joints

These can damage the surface finish or cause warping, swelling, or discoloration over time.

Hardware & Accessories

- Handles, hinges, and drawer slides can be wiped with a damp cloth and mild soap if needed.
- Avoid lubricants unless recommended by FC Closets LLC.
- If you notice squeaks or loosened hardware, contact us before attempting self-repair.

Environmental Tips

- Maintain indoor humidity levels between 35%–55% to prevent expansion or contraction.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to reduce the risk of fading or surface discoloration.
- Keep heat sources (such as irons, hair dryers, or candles) away from closet surfaces.
