REFOCUSING – No Time to Waste

Summer will be behind us in moments. How quickly time passes anymore! Fall (and cooler temperatures – Yes!). Winter. Another year will be gone. And what have we made of it? How many more cycles do we have still ahead? And so it feels with every passing year.

Jeremiah talked (for God) about urgency. "The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved." (Jeremiah 8:20, ESV) He refers to the urgency to turn back to God. Judgment is coming and the people have delayed any thoughts of returning to God. Soon it would be too late.

Whenever I read this passage, I think of urgency. Perhaps we are not the rebels that need to hurriedly turn to God before it's too late. But we know people who are. Their time is short. Our days to reach them are numbered as well. If we are to do anything for God, we had best act. If we delay, if we put it off, if we get distracted, time will run out. The harvest is available today. We must engage now. Soon it will be too late. The summer of the spiritual harvest will end. Engage in the harvest today.

But how? It starts with participating. When the church is doing something, be involved. What an encouragement to one another when we all pull together! Volunteer to do something: teach, drive, be a helper, be a set of eyes, visit, fix stuff, pick stuff up, put stuff down, hand stuff out, greet, be intentionally friendly to everyone – especially to visitors. The ideas are endless. We all can do something. We all have gifts from God that will create special impact, but we have to engage on purpose.

Don't underestimate the power of just being there. Church services, Bible Studies, events, etc.—see each of these items as an opportunity to invite someone. And invite them again. And keep inviting them until they come. Be intentional about bringing people.

Engage personally. Share your story. Seek to lead someone to Christ (yes you can). Pray for people in need. Especially, pray for people who have spiritual needs. And pray fervently for those who are lost. Ask me to become part of the Prayer Ministry that seeks to pray for people that are lost or that have specific spiritual needs. Let's pray for personal revival and that others we know would be revived/turn to God.

Summer will soon be gone. Fall will be too. And Winter. Let's get busy. Life is quickly passing by. Let us make the most of it for the Lord and for His kingdom.
