Need a Bit of Bahai Grass in Our Lives

(ESV) Isaiah 40:8 "The grass withers, the flower fades, but the Bahai Grass will stand forever." That is not exactly how that verse reads. But it could.

Bahai Grass is invincible in summer. Around my house, everything will start to die or go dormant now that that summer has begun. But not Bahai. The hotter it is the better. Rain? Not necessary. Mow it? I think the stems see me coming and lay down, only to pop back up after I go over it. And those stems are hard as steel. Just ask my mower blades. And vigorous in the face of adversity? I am sure the stems grow about 6 inches a day. How can it produce seed heads in less than a week after being mowed down?

I did not know that you can actually order Bahai seeds for your lawn. Are you kidding? And in the advertisement, it gives all the characteristics that make it great: Full Sun – grows best in summer to early fall. Drought resistant, only needs a little humidity to prosper. Grows readily in poor sandy soil, acidic with little nutrients. It may not be very pretty, but boy is it hardy in a land where nothing else can grow.

You know, maybe we can learn something here. What if we were resistant to harsh conditions – able

to prosper when times were hard? What if we refused to be deterred by opposition and just stood right back up when we are mowed down? What if we didn't need to be pampered all the time? What if we quickly produced fruit over and over again? What if we always prospered, and even more so during tough times? In fact, that is what occurred in early Christianity.

But how? I don't know the secret of Bahai grass, but I do know the secrets for Christian living. Psalms 1 describes the man of God. The one who feeds off the Word of God. (ESV) Psalms 1:3 "He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers." Being filled with the Word of God. Meditating on what the Lord has said: Offering His presence, His peace, His encouragement, His promises, His forgiveness, His living Word that changes us, His Spirit that energizes and empowers. And then embracing and yielding to all He says. Prosperity when all else is withered and dead.

Let's prosper this summer. Let's engage with the Lord. Hear Him. Respond to Him. Make Him the focus of our life. We can stand strong like Bahai Grass. And be much more useful as well.
