Attendance numbers had been down since COVID had struck. We just couldn't seem to get back to normal again. But now the last couple of months, attendance has skyrocketed. Averaging in the 80s, we even had a month over 100. It seems visitors are showing up every week. We have seen several people join the church and one adult baptized, and many others who seem to be at the point of joining. What an awesome God!

There seems to be excitement and optimism everywhere. What new thing will our Lord do? There are many upcoming events for the summer. VBS. Youth Camp. Women's Tea. A number of other special events. Let's all be part of it! Let's volunteer to work! Let's pray! Let's participate! Let's pray that God might continue to demonstrate His greatness in our midst. What an awesome God!
