"We were gentle among you, like a nursing mother taking care of her own children. 8 So, being affectionately desirous of you, we were ready to share with you not only the gospel of God but also our own selves, because you had become very dear to us." His impact was the result of this mother-like spirit that he had. We desperately need more of this in society and in the church.

Gentleness. Tender care. Fond affection. Sharing ourselves. Doesn't this describe what a mother should be! I hope others can remember their own mothers with these words. I can. And what an impact it had on me. I seldom deserved it, but that did not change my mom's attitude toward me. I was special, not because of anything in me, but because she chose to love me as if I was special.

I thank God for our mothers. They reflect the heart of God (perhaps especially in the person of the Holy Spirit). Unconditional love. Gently wooing. Encouraging. Helping with gracious compassion. Causing children to want to be the best they can be. Maybe

mothers who gave birth to these children. Maybe 'mothers' who love these children as if they were their own. In every case having a radical impact on young lives.

Mother's Day is special because of those being honored. Mothers deserve honor. These who invested their lives in us — even when we didn't appreciate it / didn't deserve it. Loving without condition. I want to say thank you for all that you are and all that you have been. May the Lord reproduce your spirit in all of us.
