Financially, that would result in greater security as we age. Spiritually, that would ensure that our lives would be spent with purpose. With eternity in minds.

Perhaps investment is not the right term when we talk about the 'spiritual'. It is really about a person, an everyday relationship with Christ. It is really about allowing Christ to dwell in us and shape our entire being. It really is all about Him. The Christian life is not about compartmentalization — finding moments to give Him. He needs to be infused if all of life. More than investing moments, we need to surrender all of life. In this there is great reward.
