Sportsman's Paradise POA was recently served a legal summons in the district court of Henderson County by Raul and Tracy Delagarza and Tony and Kandas Tucker who are members of the association. The lawsuit is posted on the Sportsman's Paradise website and contains serious allegations that required the board of directors to hire legal counsel. Our attorney, Brian Richardson, stated in a recent meeting, should this case go to trial, attorneys' fees could be in the tens of thousands of dollars. It is our hope that it does not come to that, however, should it become reality, the board may have to levy a special assessment to cover attorneys' fees.

We plan on opening the pool as scheduled in 2024. However, the pool is on its last leg and needs many expensive repairs. The board has been looking at options moving forward, and it is our goal to have a ballot measure on the future of the pool at our annual meeting next September.
