Valor Defense Depot Training

Basic Pistol Course

Student class requirements

Firearm- Semi-auto or revolver (If you need to rent a firearm for the class you will need to make a rental arrangement **prior** to attending the class so that we can have your firearm ready prior to the beginning of class)

Holster (Preferably an outside the waistband holster for Basic Pistol Course but an inside the waistband holster can be used)

*Battle belts are allowed if they are set up appropriately (mag pouches, appropriate holster)

200 rounds of Factory Box Ammo. No reloads will be allowed on the range for this course.

3 magazines for semi-auto pistols. 3 speed loaders are recommended for anyone shooting a revolver.

Dress appropriate for the weather

Basic Range Attire:

- -Hat (Required item as a hat helps to prevent hot brass or other debris from hitting the shooter in the eyes)
- -ANSI Z87 rated eye pro. Prescription eye glasses meet this standard. All other eyewear that meets this standard will most often have it printed on the frame. All Oakley glasses are made to this standard. Tinted lenses are fine. Clear lenses are the best option for cloudy days. No gas station sunglasses. (Clear lenses available for purchase in-store)
- -Hearing protection- Foam inserts, over the ear headsets, electronic hearing pro(over the ear or in the ear). Hearing pro must be of a type that is specifically made for shooting. No music headphones or other items that are not specifically made for use with firearms will be allowed on the range. (Foam inserts available in-store)
- -Shirts must have sleeves, short or long. No sleeveless shirts will be allowed
- -Long sleeve sunshirts are recommended for hot weather. Do not wear excessively loose clothing as it tends to catch in between the weapon and holster, or prevents the student from executing a proper presentation.
- -Pants, preferably with cargo pockets. No shorts

- -Close-toed shoes or boots. No sandals, crocs, flip-flops...
- -Tourniquet (Available for purchase in-store)
- -Water bottle (Water will be provided but you will need a container to drink from)
- *Sunscreen is recommended for sunny days
- -Student must be at least 21 yrs. of age
- -General good health
- -Must be able to physically operate a firearm without assistance

Disqualifications for attending VDD firearms training-

- -Felony conviction of ANY crime from ANY state
- -Conviction for any crime that legally prohibits a person from owning/possessing a firearm in ANY state
- -Any conviction for stalking or domestic abuse
