A Note From Director / Lead Producer / Writer / Composer Eli Bauman

In 2016, when a certain Reality TV star was vying for the Presidency – I am of course talking about "Dancing with the Stars" contestant, Rick Perry – I thought back to my time working on the Obama '08 campaign in Las Vegas. I knocked on thousands of doors, registered hundreds of voters, and was invited inside the home of an undecided voter to partake in an afternoon orgy (I politely declined, but did convince the entire orgy to vote for Obama). But most of all, I was inspired - inspired to do more, to do better, to believe in something... Then eight short years later, wondering how everything had so quickly gone down the toilet, I reached inside the bowl and found inspiration again. If any buffoon with zero qualifications can become President, then why couldn't I, also a buffoon with zero qualifications, write my first Musical? Sure, I was a 34-year-old who hadn't written a song since high-school, and who didn't know how to play an instrument, and who couldn't read a line of music... but why shouldn't I hope for a change? So, I figured, f**k it. Four years and fifty songs later, I had my first full draft of 44.

Eli was born and raised in Los Angeles to his mother Mary, a therapist for special needs children, and father, Jon, also known as "Bowzer" from the retro 50's nostalgia TV show/most random band to play Woodstock, "Sha Na Na." After enduring this not remotely strange childhood, Eli graduated from Columbia University with a degree in English and Creative Writing. Upon graduation, Eli toured the country with his father, singing in casinos ranging from the 10,000 seat "Mohegan Sun Arena" to the utterly depressing "Boomtown Casino" in Biloxi, Mississippi. After moving back to LA in 2007 to pursue a career in Hollywood, Eli gave up the glamorous world of television production for the even more glamorous world of political campaigning, moving to Las Vegas' largest and hottest county to organize for radical fringe candidate, Barack Obama, whom we've never heard from

since. After the campaign, Eli coordinated Veteran's Affairs for Obama's 2009 Inaugural Committee and interned for ABC's Special Investigative Unit, where he was shoved by disgraced bamboozler, Bernie Madoff. Later, Eli transitioned back to scripted television, writing episodes of FX's "Lights Out" and NBC's "Prime Suspect," before moving onto variety television, including the Emmy's, the ESPY's, the Emmy nominated "ACLU: Stand For Rights with Tom Hanks" and the Writer's Guild Award nominated "Maya and Marty" with Maya Rudolph and Martin Short. Most recently, Eli has entered the highly lucrative world of musical theater and contributed material to the fraudulently "won" Biden campaign. Eli resides in Los Angeles with his wonderful and far more talented wife, Joanna, their spectacular daughter, Ivy, their new-ly-arrived sweetheart of a son, Charlie, and their old toothless dog, Leon.

In addition to her business and artistic endeavours, Monica has furthered the philanthropic legacy of her late father, John Saunders, supporting numerous charities both as an individual and through The Saunders Family Foundation, for which she has served as Chair and Executive Director for the last 26 years. She is also a founding partner of The Growth Project, which connects business leaders with charities to help maximise their impact on the world. She is also a Founding Angel and dedicated board member of Feel The Magic, a charity that supports grieving kids and families.

This wealth of diverse experience has led Monica to her current role as Lead Producer of 44, where alongside producing partner and writer/director, Eli Bauman, she has used her creative instincts and business acumen to help bring an artistic vision to life, as well as her philanthropic passion to maximize its social impact. With sold-out runs in Los Angeles, New York and Chicago, this off-beat political satire is set to continue its success with performances scheduled throughout the United States and abroad in 2025.

Monica resides between Sydney and LA, where she loves to bring family and friends together through cooking and entertaining. Her life's greatest joy is her three teenage boys - Brooklyn, Ashton and Hudson.

Steve McKeever



Steve McKeever, founder and CEO of Hidden Beach Recordings, has been recognized as "one of the top 50 African-American power brokers in entertainment" by Black Enterprise magazine. Steve began producing concerts and radio programs while attending the University of Illinois and later became Head of Programming for the Harvard Law School speakers' forum. After practicing entertainment law at elite firms, he joined PolyGram as Head of West Coast Business Affairs, where he brought the comedian Robin Harris to the Wing label and produced the conic Bebe's Kid's album.

At 29, Steve was tapped as GM, Senior Vice President & Head of A&R at Motown Records, where he signed Queen Latifah, Norman Brown, Zhane' and oversaw albums for Boyz II Men, Stevie Wonder, and Lionel Richie. He eventually rose to Executive Vice President, spearheading new business ventures such as founding MoJazz Records, Motown's highest ROI division. His leadership saw over \$700M in sales and led him to testify before the U.S. Senate on entertainment imagery.

In 1997, Steve founded Hidden Beach Recordings. The label launched Grammy winner Jill Scott, Kindred The Family Soul, Darius Rucker's solo career, and the Billboard-topping Unwrapped series, while collaborating with artists like Bebe Winans, Brenda Russell, Prince, and Stevie Wonder. Hidden Beach has mentored over 750 interns and made history by producing the first-ever presidential campaign music album. Steve was later tapped by the 2008 Presidential Inaugural Committee to produce the first official music collection, and Hidden Beach will soon release the soundtrack to 44.

Steve also served as Executive Producer for the nationally televised MLK Memorial unveiling on the DC National Mall. He sits on the board of Ares Capital Corp and is a former Grammys Governor. Steve and his wife Candace share two children, Brent and Maddox, and adore their lovable Vizsla, Nelson.

Conrad is a Grammy-nominated multi-instrumentalist, songwriter, producer, and videographer driven by a passion for creating music and visuals that leave a lasting impact. His musical journey began with violin and cello in competitive youth orchestras, but it truly ignited the day his dad's work truck speakers blasted Van Halen, Dio, and Pink Floyd, sparking a lifelong love for the guitar.

Building his career through collaborations with LA's vibrant creative community, Conrad's work has spanned television, film, video games, and tours with artists including 80's icon Annabella Lwin of Bow Wow, bringing music to sold-out audiences around the world.

Offstage, Conrad shares his life with his wife, Brittny, and their children, Jackson and Avery, whose love and encouragement fuel his drive to push the boundaries of music and art.

Raised in Venice, CA, Anthony "Brew" Brewster is a powerhouse producer, music director, and keyboardist whose career spans multiple genres and industries. With roots in soul, R&B, and rock, he has spent decades shaping the sound of Los Angeles, blending deep musicality with cutting-edge production. His journey is one of constant evolution, fueled by a love for collaboration and a passion for pushing music forward.

Brewster's production credits include work for Fox, Hidden Beach Records, and Beacon Street Studios, where he played a key role in crafting award-winning compositions. His work with Beacon Street Studios earned Telly Awards for outstanding commercial music, further cementing his reputation for excellence in scoring and production.

As a Grammy-nominated producer, Brewster has contributed to groundbreaking projects, including work with Ant Clemons and Ghanaian reggae artist Rocky Dawuni.
