Position Description: The Marketing & Communications Internship offers the intern the opportunity for hands-on experience in economic and community development. The intern will participate and develop programs that help achieve the mission of the HADF and help execute the marketing campaign of the Foundation. Tasks may include: research, social media management, database management, digitization of files, creation of marketing materials, coordinating meetings and events, and other duties as assigned. - Brainstorm ways the HADF can help increase development in Hartford
- Find and write grants that assist in the accomplishment of the HADF's program of work
- Manage presence at the Turner County Fair (August 17th 20th)
- Other duties as assigned by the Board or Director

Skills/Experience/Interest Required: Ideal candidates will be undergraduate students, preferably rising juniors or seniors, majoring in Business, Communications, Marketing, Government, or a related field with an interest in economic and community development.
