PICKING UP YOUR HOAGIE ORDER

Orders are picked up by *seniority* and are to be picked up at these *approximate* times:

9:15 Seniors 9:30 Juniors 9:45 Sophomores 10:00 Freshmen

If we are running behind or ahead of schedule, a REMIND message will be sent so you can plan accordingly. Please be courteous and on time!!!

<u>YOU</u> are responsible for counting your order. Please make sure you have the correct amount and TYPE of hoagies, not just the total count. You MUST make sure this is complete BEFORE leaving the order pickup area. Once you sign the order slip and pay we will not return or exchange any food item. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Payment/Credit

Hoagies must be paid for when picked up.

No change will be given for cash. All "change" will be received as cash credit to the

student account.

The hoagie profit will be split 60/40 just like all other fundraisers. Students receive \$3.00 for each hoagie sold and the boosters receive \$2.00 for each hoagie sold. (subject to change due to price increases. You will be notified if this happens)

SCHEDULED WORK DATES

ALL students must work **THREE** hoagie sales each year. This is a requirement to be in the marching band and to earn your Letterman jacket and invitation to the end of year banquet. You must work THREE scheduled sales even if you are not going on the trip.

Parents are required to work **ONE** hoagie sale per student enrolled in the marching band. Parents **CANNOT** work a hoagie sale in place of their student! There is a \$150 parent only buyout per student.

Students **CANNOT** work a hoagie sale for another student!

ALL Band Officers are required to work **EVERY** hoagie sale.

NEW This year you will have TWO (2) weeks to schedule your hoagie sales of your choice (date and shift) on the Sign Up Genius (you will get a REMIND when this will be posted). If you (student and parent) do not schedule your THREE hoagie sales within the two weeks the Hoagie Chairperson will at that time schedule your days for you.

If a parent or student is unable to work their scheduled sale, it is the **student/parent's responsibility to contact the Hoagie Chairperson and the sale will be rescheduled.

WORKING YOUR HOAGIE SALE

ALL students and parents **must** sign in upon arrival and be signed out for the day to count.

If you arrive for your scheduled sale and leave early, that hoagie sale **will not count toward your required sales.

- The following are public health regulations and are MANDATORY FOR EVERYONE, NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Everyone MUST wear provided gloves while handling hoagie supplies. Please get NEW GLOVES if you use the tinkletorium (restroom), changing stations/hoagie table, or if you touch anything (seat, floor, person next to you, nose, head,phone) ANYTHING!
- Hair and beard nets MUST be worn.
- Clothes must be free from pet hair.
- NO eating or drinking while making hoagies.
- NO items used in making hoagies should be eaten at any time.
- DO NOT throw any food items.
- NO cell phones permitted while making hoagies. If seen out it will be taken to the end of your shift. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Students will be dismissed by the Hoagie Chairperson after all hoagies are made and clean up is complete.

If there are any extra hoagies at the end of the morning, they are sold after all hoagies are picked up on a first come basis by the Hoagie Chairperson.

**Students & Parents: MUST see Hoagie Chairperson (Dawn Mowat) to sign out or shift WILL NOT count.

We welcome any adult to volunteer for extra days and help with the hoagies! We really do have fun!
