4 \$500 scholarships will be distributed. 2 specifically in the Phoenix Central School District and 2 will go Oswego County Residents.

ELIGIBILITY

- Student must be a senior in high school.
- Student must have maintained between a 2.0 and 4.0 GPA throughout his or her final two years in high school.
- Student must have volunteered for a minimum of 100 hours for organizations fighting food insecurity or have overcome a significant family or emotional hardship. Specifics should be included in essay.
- Student should be able to produce two Letters of Recommendation (one of which should be from a teacher or administrative staff member).
- Student must show an acceptance letter to attend college or technical school the semester following his or her high school graduation. Letter should be shown at time of distribution.

REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for a scholarship, a graduating high school senior must:

1. Complete the **current (2023)** prescribed application, answering all questions.
2. Attach a **certified transcript** of his or her high school grades.
3. Include a copy of a **letter of acceptance** from the trade school, college, or university

If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, the

Erin's Angels scholarship committee must receive a copy of the letter of acceptance before making an award.

4. All documentation must reach the Committee no later than the announced deadline for application.
